Examinations expectations for Year 11.

We have been very fortunate this year with a high proportion of our year 11 pupils already sitting some of the GCSE's and passing with level 4's of greater. GCSE Examinations.

English:

Students are continuing their GCSE English Literature and Language for examination in June 2023. English language will also be assessed in June 2022 with AQA examination board. This year they will have the added subject of poetry.

Maths:

As with English the pupils are revising the GCSE syllabus for assessment in June 2023. They will also be attempting a Functional Skills exam during Spring Term.
