

Being a Caretaker – Mr Whittall visits Primary

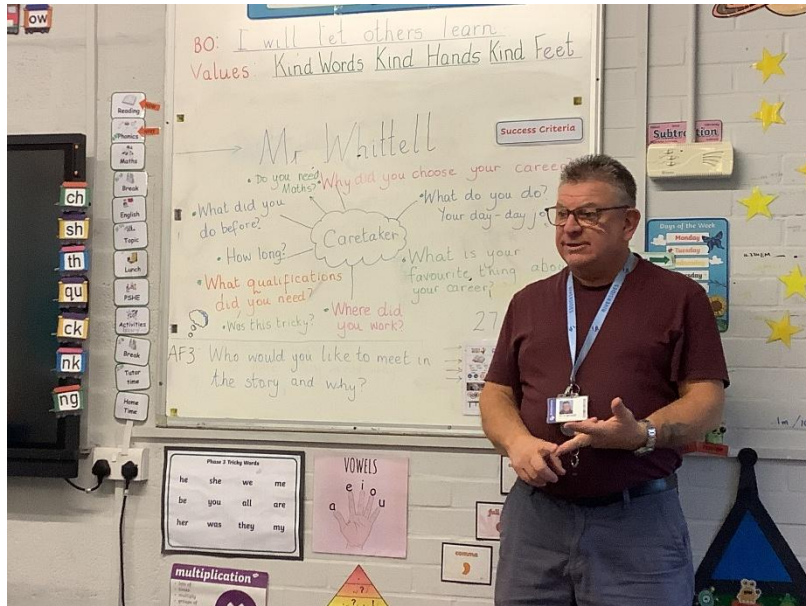

Aim of the activity

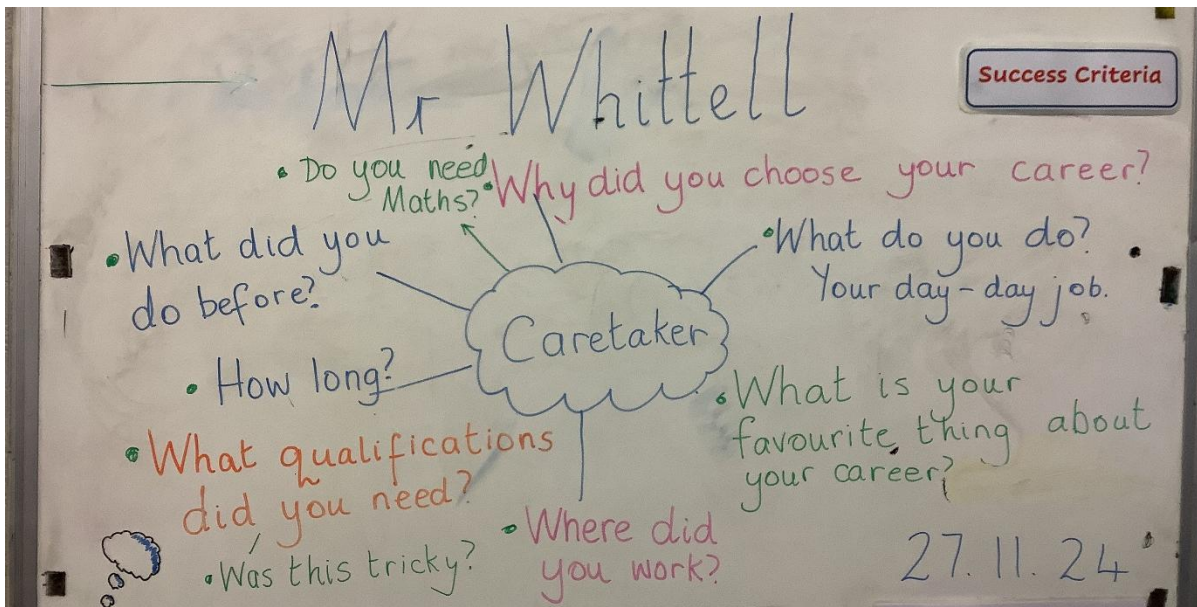
As part of the introduction to Careers Pathway in Primary Mr Whittall gave a Careers talk to P1 and P3 today.
